Notes will go home Monday to parents and carers to make selections regarding Special Religious Education, Ethics and the Non Scripture programs. Please choose carefully as changes will not be made once the groups have been set.

MORNING SUPERVISION

Please be reminded that morning supervision does not begin until 8:30am. We understand that parents have work commitments, however if you require supervision prior to 8:30am, you will need to organise before school care. Please contact the office if you require information about providers.

ABSENCES

All absences must be explained in writing (or email –please remember to include your child's name and class) within seven days of the student's return to school.

SCHOOL FEES and LEVIES

Accounts will soon go home regarding this year's school fees and levies. Parents are asked not to send payment in until you have received your account.

School Fees ... School Fees are a voluntary contribution the school seeks from parents to help in the payment of exercise books, art & craft supplies, maths & science equipment, classroom & home readers and first aid supplies. This year School Fees are set at \$30.00 per child.

Online Maths ... In previous years, students in Years 3 to 6 were asked to purchase maths textbooks to use in class. This year online learning will be introduced with students having access to the programs at school and at home. Costs are still being finalised.

Paper Levies ... Kindergarten and Year 1 students will be charged a paper levy due to the resources used in class. Paper levies are \$12.00 per student for the year.

My Dictionary ... Kindergarten and new students in Year 1 and Year 2 are also asked to purchase, through school, a "Personal Word Book". This book is kept at the end of Kinder and Year 1 and returned to students in the new year. Personal Word Books are \$5.00.

WORKING WITH CHILDREN DECLARATION

LAKE ROAD ROAD WORKS ...

As works to address long term traffic flow in Port Macquarie's industrial area continue, the east bound lane of Lake Rd between the Oxley Highway roundabout and Fernhill Road will close to traffic for three days from 6am on Tuesday 13 February until 6pm on Thursday 15 February. The closure is necessary to complete asphalting works on the left westbound lane, including the intersections at Toorak Court and Carriage Way.

A detour will be in place during the closure, with traffic travelling east on the Oxley Highway advised to access Lake Road via Fernhill Road. The west bound lane on Lake Road will remain open under changed traffic conditions.
