CLASSES FOR 2019

A great way to support children feeling a bit anxious is helping them to prepare for the change. Acknowledge the things that will be different and also highlight all the things that remain the same. Talk about ways to manage anxious and nervous emotions, for example taking big breaths, using self-talk and thinking about all the possibilities of having a new teacher and new friends. It is also very important to acknowledge these feelings as normal emotions. Managing ourselves in times of change is an important life skill but all children need support, encouragement and positivity to learn this self-management.

The first day back for all returning students going into Years 1 to 6 in 2019 is Wednesday, 30th January. On arrival at school keep your school bag with you and make your way to the COLA to catch up with friends. You will be welcomed back at 9am morning assembly and directed to a classroom with your 2018 teacher (wherever possible). 2019 classes will not be formed until new enrolments are confirmed, which may not be until Thursday or Friday.
