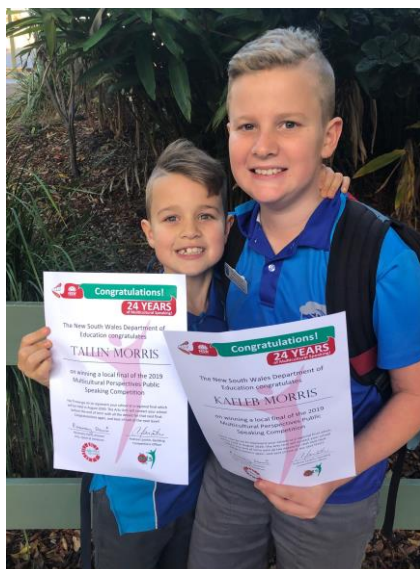

MULTICULTURAL PUBLIC SPEAKING

Congratulations to the students of Beechwood, Kempsey West, Lake Cathie, Laurieton, Port Macquarie, Tacking Point, Telegraph Point and Hastings Public Schools who participated in the District Finals of the Multicultural Public Speaking competition at Hastings yesterday. 
