The general comment is limited to key information especially indicating focus areas for Semester 2. Naturally, as we settle back into Term 3 and we continue to gain more normality of school routines, teachers will gain far more detailed information on student learning progress. As always, if you would like to check in with your child's teacher during Term 3, teachers are happy to provide updates.


