School Upgrades and Maintenance

We continue to prioritise creating and maintaining a healthy and engaging environment at Hastings for both students, staff and the community. Work taking place over the holidays and early in Term 3 includes an upgrade to our current PA system that will improve the overall functioning of communication across our school. The staffroom is undergoing a much needed facelift to cope with the large staff. This will include facilitates for effective staff learning programs, access to technology and compliance with current work, health and safety standards.

The annual Bushfire Mitigation and Vegetation management program is due to take place again. Hastings Public School is classified as a High Risk School for bushfires and obviously, after the devastating bushfires of 2019-20, we need to make sure that we comply with safety measures in readiness for the upcoming bushfire season. However, we will be consulting with Department representatives and the contractors to ensure that the process is both ensuring safety and being mindful of local environmental priorities and requirements. Thank you to the P&C who have been very helpful in offering the expertise of some of our community members with relevant local knowledge to support the process.

Staff Development Day

Staff will gather on Monday 20th July for our Term 3 Staff Development Day. Staff will be working in Stage teams on our school priority of Assessment. Teachers will be designing quality assessment tasks to match teaching and learning programs that allow for timely feedback to students, as well as guiding teaching and learning programs. Teachers will be continuing to develop and deepen their knowledge, understanding and skills of a range of strategies for assessment that contribute to improved learning outcomes for students. Three staff members will be attending a professional learning day at Port Macquarie Public School which will be delivered by Sue Larkey, a well-known expert in supporting students on the Autism Spectrum. A number of our teachers have now received this training and we will continue to build teacher capability in this area.

School Routines in Term 3

We continue to operate based on current advice from the Department of Education and NSW Health. There have been no updates or changes to date in relation to restriction of adults on school sites. We will therefore plan to have the same arrangements for drop off and pick up at the start of Term 3. Whilst everyone is aware that this is the way it has to be at the moment, I am aware of a range of views from parents. Some parents have been impressed by the strategy and have enjoyed seeing the growth of independence in their children. Other parents have felt a very personal response and feel as though they are missing out on experiences with their children. We understand both views and accept that no strategy is going to be pleasing to everyone. We are however attempting to support everyone to deal with this new way of operating. While I empathise that frustrations are experienced, these are best dealt with by talking emotions through, working out ways to work through them and maintaining positive relationships. Rarely is a problem solved or an emotion settled by complaining or blaming through social media.

School Counsellor Service

There has been a complete review of school counsellor allocations this term and counsellors across the whole Hastings Network have been re-allocated. This means that both Dawn Dockrill and David Bruce are moving to other schools. Dawn has supported our school community for many years and as such, has been a huge support to many families. I would like to acknowledge and thank her for her immense drive and passion for supporting children and wish her well for the upcoming change. Likewise, even though David has only been with us for a year, his commitment to supporting children and families has been a significant advantage to our school community. Thank you to you both and all the best for the future. In Term 3, we have a new counsellor joining our team, Fiona Harvey. Kasia Hahn, has worked with us previously and will be joining us again.

Due to money handling recommendations, Student Banking will recommence Term 4. Parents are encouraged to deposit directly to their local Commonwealth Bank branch or online.








