## **PRINCIPAL MATTERS**

#### **Education Week**

Education Week is being held next week. This year's theme is 'Lifelong learners' and celebrates education as a lifelong journey from before a child enters an early childhood setting, progressing to primary and secondary school, and continuing their learning journey into adulthood; learning a trade, entering tertiary education, or the workforce.

Due to current COVID -19 restrictions our Assembly of Achievement will proceed however we are unable to have any parents, carers and/or visitors in attendance. Our school is extremely disappointed about this, as we know you will be. We have organised to have the assembly recorded so we can share this video with our wider community, and we will also have professional photos taken. These will not be immediately available on the day as they will take time to publish but we will make them available as soon as possible.

#### **Canberra Excursion**

Thank you to the parents and carers who returned their excursion preference form. The most popular option was to try and re-book the excursion for later in the year. Mr Scott has been in touch with Port Stephens Coaches (the company coordinating the excursion) to secure a date in Term 4. Once this date is confirmed an additional note will be sent to parents and carers where parents can select for their child to attend or to receive a refund. We expect fewer students to attend the re-scheduled excursion so the number of teachers attending may also drop. If this is the case, it will enable students who are not attending the excursion to be taught by a Year 6 teacher or teachers.
